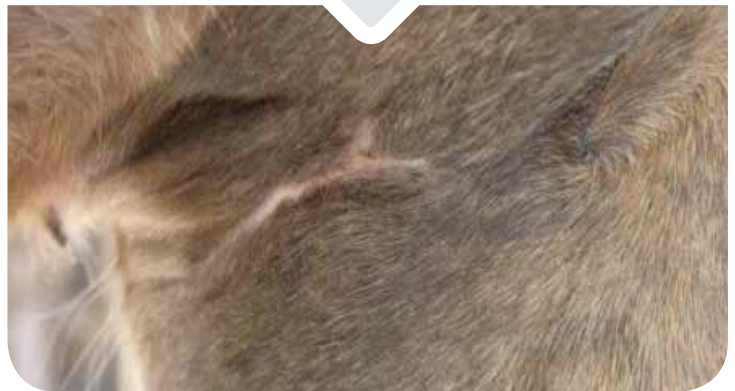


Horse with Laceration to Lower Chest
